And surrender Arianna Noppenberger did when she designed this stunningly minimalist master suite. “You’ll never overwhelm that setting,” Arianna says. *“Our intent was to be so minimal that the design captures the magnificence of the ocean view. In the day you have rock formations, endless blue, and Catalina Island; at night the amazing silvery reflection of the moon and shimmering everywhere.”* Inside, they used neutrals—fumed brushed oak floors, Buxiel gray limestone walls, and Tabu Caleidolegno veneered cabinets—to create a soothing foil for the marine blues outside. She and architect husband Horst Noppenberger situated their clients’ home to ensure complete privacy, allowing them to use ample glass walls giving onto a wraparound deck, thus eliminating any sense of separation from nature. “They could run around naked if they wanted to.” >
